The tea house sells brewed and loose teas, baked delicacies and imported tea wares. During the open house, free hors d'oeuvres and beverages — including a sampling of several of the 121 teas that are regularly available — will be served.

Owners Rusty Bishop and Mike Feller, who opened Gong Fu in the

old Antler's restaurant, have announced plans to renovate the south side of their building, in what was the bar side of Antler's. Bishop said they are not prepared to announce what will be there just yet, but he did say it won't be additional seating for the tea shop.

Mail orders for Gong Fu's tea have been received from 36 states. As a result, Bishop and Feller have plans to add a Web site for customers to place orders. It may be running by October.
